Appendix 1

Shaping the future: Have your say on London Gatwick's Route 4 Airspace Change

Dear Horne Parish Council,

London Gatwick is progressing an airspace change proposal (ACP) to reintroduce satellite-based navigation procedures on one of our aircraft departure routes – known as Route 4.

This proposal is essential because the ground-based navigation is gradually being phased out as part of a government programme to modernise UK airspace. All of London Gatwick's other arrival and Main Runway departure routes have successfully adopted the new navigation procedures, leaving Route 4 as the only one needing updating.

Through engagement with community representatives and other key stakeholders, London Gatwick has developed and agreed the shortlisted options for the future of Route 4.

In accordance with the process set out by the UK's airspace regulator – the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) – London Gatwick is now gathering feedback on its shortlisted options as part of a 14-week consultation period starting on Tuesday 20 January 2026 and ending at 23:59 on Tuesday 28 April 2026.

The public consultation is open to anyone with an interest in this airspace change. The aim of the public consultation is to ensure everyone who wants to feedback has that opportunity before London Gatwick selects a final option which will be submitted to the CAA for formal approval.
